What is God calling me to give?

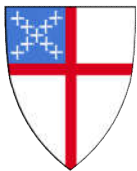
You are invited to prayerfully consider how God has gifted you with treasures, time and talents. Explore in prayer what you feel God is calling you to commit to the Church.
